



## **Tardy Policy**

Students will suffer no consequences on the **first tardy**. The **second tardy** will result in a conference with a school administrator. A parent/guardian will be contacted on the **third tardy**. The student will be assigned to Friday morning detention on the **fourth tardy**. The **fifth tardy** will result in ISS (In School Suspension). Students who have acquired **six tardies** will be assigned to Saturday school. After receiving **seven tardies**, students will be sent to Alternative School for a minimum of ten days.

### **Morning Detention (4 tardies)**

Morning detention will begin at 6:30am. Parents/guardians must provide transportation to early morning detention. No bus service will be provided. A notification letter will be sent home when a student is assigned early morning detention. Friday morning detention will be administered at least twice monthly.

### **In-School Suspension (5 tardies)**

ISS begins after homeroom and concludes at the end of the school day. Students complete classwork in an alternate setting with supervision provided by the Assistant Principal.

### **Saturday School (6 tardies)**

Saturday school takes place here at LFHS. A notification letter will be sent home when a student is assigned to Saturday school. Saturday school is held on designated Saturdays from 7:00am-11:00am. Students will be assigned community service duties throughout the campus. Parents/guardians must provide transportation to and from Saturday school. Students who fail to attend Saturday school will be assigned to Alternative School for a minimum of ten days.

### **Alternative School (7 tardies)**

The Blount County Allgood Alternative Program is housed at 45 Community Road, Oneonta. The Blount County Alternative Program is governed under Board Policy 5.23 on Page 40 of the *Student Code of Conduct*.
